SUMMARY

Installs machinery and equipment in industrial establishment by performing the following duties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Other duties may be assigned.

- Reads blueprints and schematic drawings to determine work procedures.
- Dismantles machines.
- Moves machinery and equipment.
- Assembles and installs equipment such as conveyors, dryers and burners.
- Welds structural steel and machine components.
- Installs compressed air piping, elevator leg spouting and dust systems.
- Constructs foundation for machines.
- Aligns machines and equipment.
- Assembles machines and bolts, welds, rivets, or otherwise fastens them to foundation or other structures.
- Repairs and lubricates machines and equipment.
- Erects buildings.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills, and/or abilities required. EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

LANGUAGE SKILLS

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. WORK ENVIRONMENT
